What is SB 472:

SB 472 (Reading and Mathematics Professional Development Institutes) is the legislation that funds and aligns professional development to State Board Adopted standards based curricula to increase student achievement in reading/language arts and mathematics.

The five-day Reading/Language Arts program specific institutes provide in depth training on how to fully implement the instructional program materials as well as the required overview of the research, state standards, and framework.

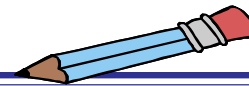
