What is VPSS?

- State-approved advanced certification process for secondary teachers in “special settings”.
- Specific subject matter knowledge with practical application targeted to hard-to-staff settings.
- Science VPSS has 2 Tiers, each Tier is a 40-hour course. To determine teacher eligibility for the VPSS and to determine whether both Tier I and Tier II are needed, please consult the district’s human resources representative.

Who is eligible for VPSS?

VPSS is designed for teachers who teach two or more core academic subjects in the following settings:

- Secondary Special Education Settings
- Secondary Alternative Programs
- Secondary Small Rural School Achievement (SRSA) programs
- Independent Study

Registration:

\$550 per Tier (includes materials, continental breakfast and lunch for Saturday sessions, and a light dinner for evening sessions)
