An Overview of the School-wide Reading Support (K-8) Professional Development Series

School-wide Reading Support is a decision-making framework that guides selection, integration, and implementation of the best evidence-based academic practices for improving reading outcomes for all students. School-wide Reading Support is not a curriculum, intervention, or practice but instead is a collaboration of district and school staff in designing reading support systems at each tier of an RtI² system.

During this overview presentation, participants will learn about the three-year School-wide Reading Support Professional Development Series that includes the following:

- establishing school-wide expectations for reading and developing school-wide reading models
- using data to make instructional and program decisions with Curriculum Based Measurements, DIBELS, and AIMSweb
- training on systematic explicit instruction
- training on strategic and intensive reading interventions

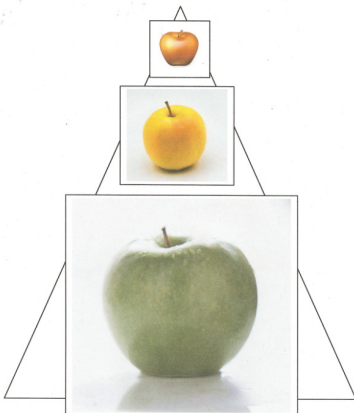
