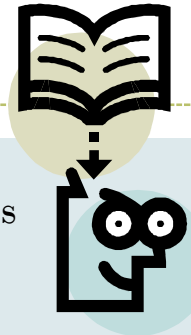
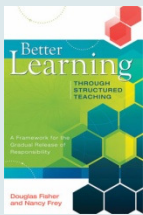


Gradual Release of Responsibility (GRR) in English Language Arts
