Course Description

This one-day training is intended for professionals who work with youth and will provide a more in-depth look at STDs/HIV including trends, transmission, consequences, STD/ HIV connection, and appropriate risk-reduction messages for this population. Available at this training will be free STD-specific resources, including "STD 101 for Teens" PowerPoint, and *Making the Connection Between STDs and HIV* Lesson Plans.

After completing this course participants will be able to:

- Summarize STD trends locally and nationally
- Describe common STDs and their symptoms
- Describe the similarities, differences, and inter-relationship between HIV and STDs
- Describe which behaviors are high-risk for STD and HIV transmission
- Provide clear and simple risk-reduction messages about STDs to young adults
- Understand what is required regarding sexuality education in CA Ed. Code
- Learn how to appropriately respond to sexuality questions asked by youth
