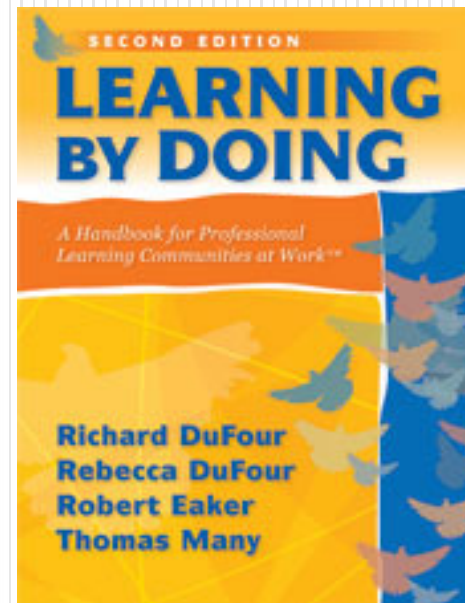
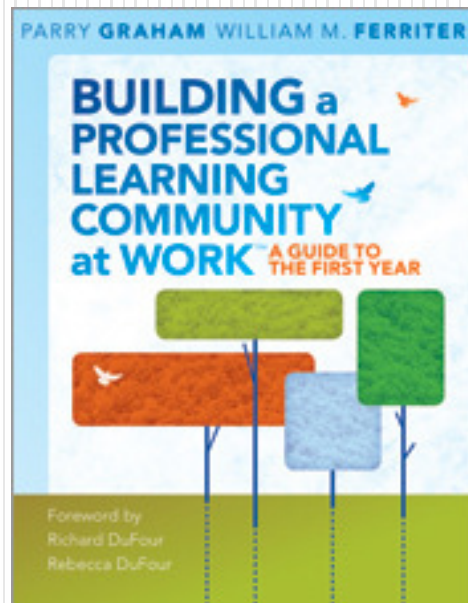

# Building and Sustaining a Professional Learning Community

1 day whole staff training, 1 day Professional Leadership Team (PLT) Leader Training, 8-hours Technical Assistance

# The 4 Interconnected Factors of a PLC



**Read** the four interconnected factors that determine the capacity of a learning community.
